## EARLY VOTERS CENTRAL TO GROWING LATINO VOTE


Prior to the 2016 Presidential elections, the majority of Spanishsurname voters cast their ballots on Election Day.

In 2016, compared to 2012, the Spanish-surname early vote increased by 90%, from 79,035 to 150,531.

In the 2018 Midterm Election, compared to the 2014 Midterm, the Spanish-surname early vote increased by 374%, from 28,948 to 133,002.

In both instances, the increase in early voters among Spanish-surname voters did not come at the expense of Election Day voters. That is, almost the same number Spanish-surnamed voters cast ballots on Election Day in the 2012, 2016 and 2018 elections.

In short, early voters are central to the increase of the Spanish-surname vote.
